Village: Maransin

Total winegrowing area: 12 hectares

Terroir: Soil of clay - 25-year-old vines - 83-meter-high - South and South-West sun exposure

Winemaking and ageing: Mechanical harvest. Traditional vinification with perfect control of temperatures for the entire production.

Blend: 75 % Merlot, 15 % Cabernet Franc, 10 % Cabernet Sauvignon.

Tasting comments: Intense and clear colour. The powerful nose opens up with ripe red fruit flavours. The palate is dense with well-blended tannins. Juicy and gourmet red fruit aromas. Th whole is balanced and fresh.
